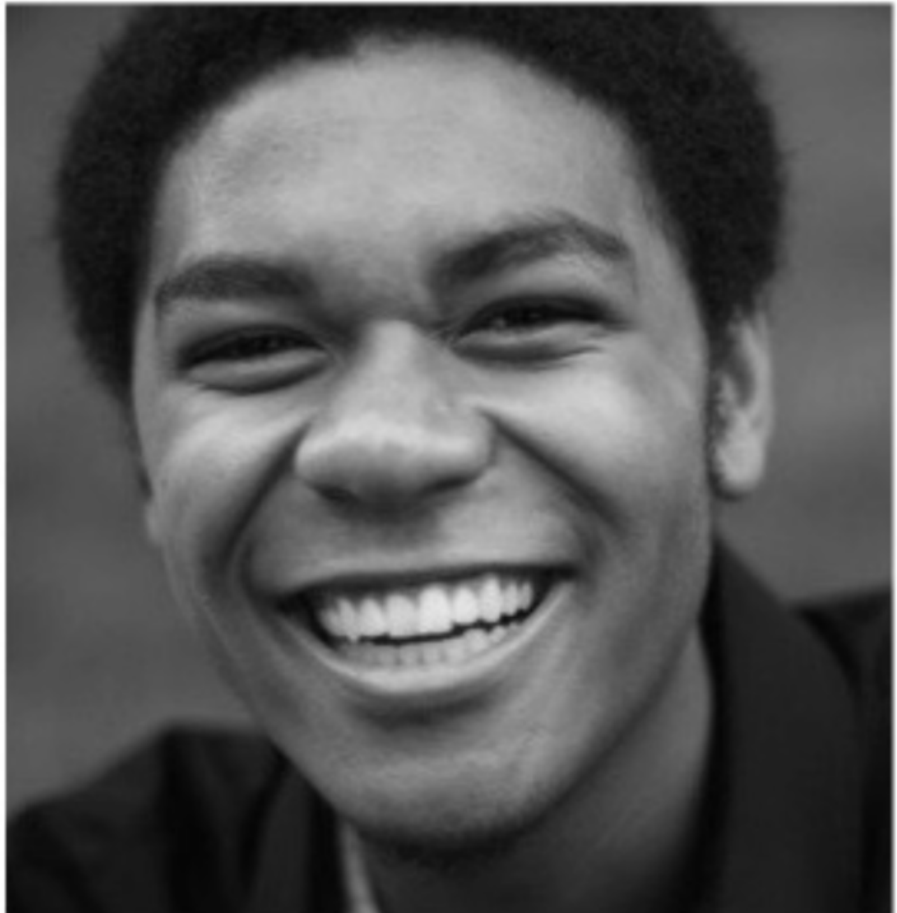

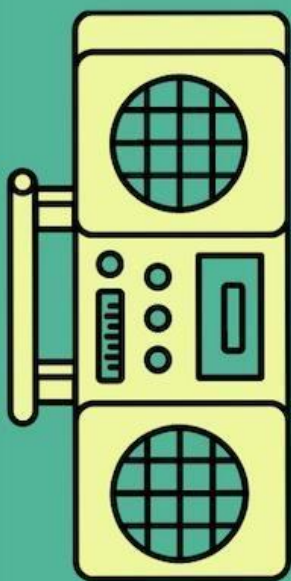

## Determine dependency status

Talk to your parents about whether they will claim you as a dependent. whether or not you can be claimed as a dependent on your parents' tax return is based on your age, student status, and who is paying the bills.

## WHAT TO BRING

-  **Social Security Number**  
Your SNN is required to submit tax return
-  **W-2 Form- Income from a job**  
If you work, expect a W-2 or a 1099 from your employer.
-  **Form 1098-T**  
This reports your school expenses. The 1098-T will already have all the expenses that were billed in your bursar, such as tuition, student fees.

## UTAH ASPIRE TRIO SCHOLARSHIP

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS – 2024 APPLICATION

**DEADLINE:** Monday, MARCH 4th midnight.

The **UTAH ASPIRE TRIO SCHOLARSHIP** is offered to outstanding entering or continuing undergraduate or graduate students selected from Utah TRIO participants. Scholarships valuing \$500 each will be awarded.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- ✓ **Active participant** in a Utah TRIO Project (Educational Talent Search, Educational Opportunity Center, Upward Bound, Veterans Upward Bound, Student Support Services or Ronald E McNair Post Baccalaureate Achievement) *who has not previously been a recipient of the Utah ASPIRE TRIO Scholarship.*
- ✓ A current **TRIO participant planning to enroll in a postsecondary institution** in Fall 2024

The **SCHOLARSHIP** is awarded on the basis of participation in and commitment to TRIO programs; academic achievement; personal, academic, and career goals; extra-curricular, service, and/or leadership activities; financial need, and other information provided.

- ✓ The application form is found at the \*link listed above. Identify your TRIO program and name of institution before you begin.
- ✓ The application will be submitted electronically and consists of 12 questions that are divided into 6 categories.
- ✓ Each question will appear independently with a textbox below.
- ✓ Answer the question thoroughly and type or cut and paste your response into the textbox provided. A preview of all 12 questions will be seen at the start of the application.
- ✓ Submit completed application as instructed online.

#### VERY IMPORTANT

- If you cannot finish this application all at once, the only way to go back is to use the same computer and web browser.
- Review your application for strong content and errors before submitting.
- You cannot edit the final document after it has been submitted. It is highly recommended that you answer the questions separately in a word document and then cut and paste the final edit into the text box provided.
- Submit your application at least several days before the deadline to ensure processing time.
