

FAFSA PREPARING FOR THE FAFSA

The FAFSA questions ask for information about your financial

situation. Depending on your circumstances (for instance whether you are a U.S. citizen or what tax form you used), you might need the following information or documents as you fill out the FAFSA application:

You will need your Social Security number or Alien Registration number

Social Security Number

if you are not a U.S. citizen. It's important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form.
