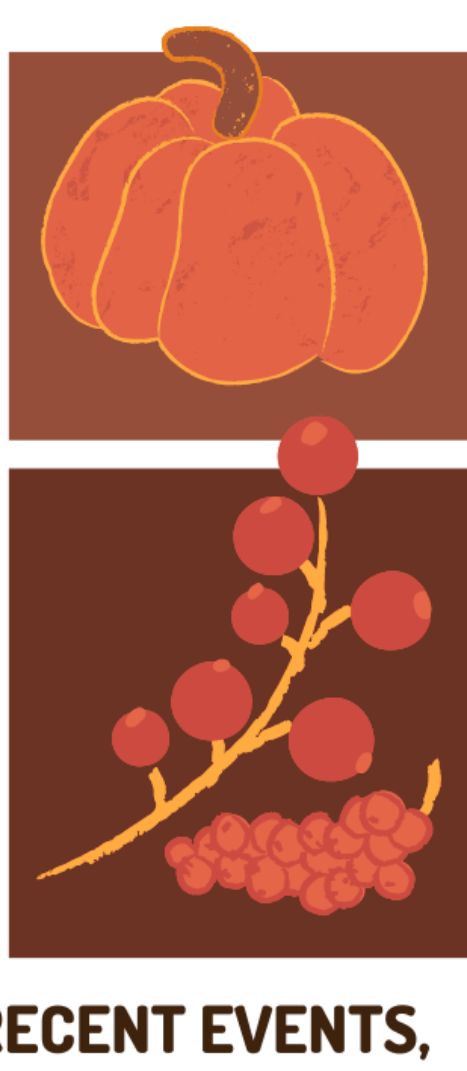

It's FAFSA Month!

If you're a senior, it's time to start thinking about your FAFSA, which is the financial aide form that makes it so you can qualify for grants, scholarships, and students loans. Rubi made this awesome infographic to help you know the requirements to filling out the form! We will also be helping seniors with this during Saturday tutoring this month!

PREPARING FOR THE FAFSA

The FAFSA questions ask for information about your financial situation. Depending on your circumstances (for instance whether you are a U.S. citizen or what tax form you used), you might need the following information or documents as you fill out the FAFSA application:

Social Security Number

You will need your Social Security number or Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. citizen. It's important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form.



Drivers License

Your drivers license could provide further evidence of your identity for security purposes.

Tax Information

- IRS W-2 Information
- IRS Form 1040

****If you are a dependent student, you will need tax information for your parents**



Untaxed Income

Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans non-education benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student.

Cash Information

Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real state (but not including the home in which you live).



FAFSA

PREPARARSE PARA LA FAFSA

Las preguntas de la FAFSA solicitan informacion referida a su persona (su nombre, fecha de nacimiento, direccion, etc.) y acerca de su situacion financiera. Segun sus circunstancias (por ejemplo, si es un ciudadano estadounidense o que formulario de declaracion de impuestos utilizo), podria necesitar la siguiente informacion o los siguientes documentos para llenar la solicitud FAFSA:

Numero de Seguro Social

Necesitara su numero de seguro social o su numero de registro de extranjeros si no es ciudadano Estadounidense. Es importante que lo introduzca correctamente en el formulario de FAFSA.



Liscensia de Conducir

Su numero de liscensia de conducir si la tiene. Su numero de liscensia puede proporcionar evidencia de su identidad.



Informacion de Impuestos

- Informacion de su IRS W-2
- Formulario 1040 del IRS

**Si es considerado un alumno dependiente, necesitara informacion sobre los impuestos de sus padres.



Ingresos no grabados

Registros de ingresos no tributales, por ejemplo, manutencion para menores, y ingresos por intereses, tanto los suyos como de sus padres si es un alumno dependiente.



Informacion sobre dinero en efectivo

Saldos de cuentas corrientes y de ahorros; inversiones, incluidas las acciones, los bonos y los inmuebles (a excepcion del domicilio habitual).
